A film where famed southern detective Benit Blanc (Daniel Craig) travels to Greece for his latest case. Sip this concoction out of a unique hanging glass and allow mysterious flavours of cachaca, laphroaig and vanilla rooibos help crack the code. Garnished with florals unique to the island of Mykonos.

THE SWIMMERS | \$35

Inspired by: The Swimmers

Premiering at The Opening Night Gala, This soaring epic dramatizes the true story of two sisters who left their home in war-torn Syria for a new life in Europe, and the chance to compete in the 2016 Summer Olympics. Inspired by Syrian flavours, cardamon, arak and anise, the cocktail is brought to life in the colour yellow, representing hope.

THE GALA | \$35

Daliland, the closing night film of Toronto International Film Festival paints a picture of the larger-than-life union of Spanish painter, Salvador and his vivacious wife, Gala. Celebrating Gala in all her glory, we've combined apple brandy from Normandy, local apple cider and calvados. Finished with a cinnamon dusting and a dehydrated gala apple.

THE WOMAN KING | \$45

Featuring a thrilling performance from Oscar winner Viola Davis, this tale brings to life the true story of the Agojie, the all-female military regiment charged with protecting the embattled African empire.
